

Early Learning Group

This is a 2 hour group which runs every week during the Victorian school term. The aim of the group is for children to explore and build skills and confidence, through play.

Parents and carers stay with their child and join in the fun too.

The group is facilitated by an experienced Early Childhood Teacher and an Allied Health Assistant in a small group setting. Each child's experience is unique and reflects their individual strengths and interests. Before your first session there will be an opportunity to visit the LEAP Centre with your child, meet the team who facilitates the group and tell us about your child's strengths, special interests, and any other information that you feel is important. We will set some goals together for your child to work towards during the term.
